

Abstain (v):</b> અબ્સ્ટેઇન - દૂર રહેવું My father abstains from wine. <b>Refrain (v):</b> રિફ્રેઇન - કશુંક કરવામાંથી દૂર રહેવું. We should refrain from telling lies. <b>3. Aboard (adv., prep.):</b> અબોર્ડ - વહાણ ઉપર He was already aboard the plane. <b>Abroad (adv.):</b> અબ્રોડ - દેશની બહાર, પરદેશ She was famous both at home and abroad. <b>4. Access (n):</b> એક્સેસ - પહોંચવાનો માર્ગ The police gained access through a broken window. <b>Excess (n):</b> ઇક્સેસ - અતિશયતા, અતિરેક Avoid anything in excess. <b>5. Assay (v):</b> અસે - સોનું, ઇ. ધાતુની ચકાસણી કરવી We assayed the metal and found it pure.
